PACEWILDENSTEIN

The "Anagrams (A Pun)" by Robert Rauschenberg are made with i-Lab Corporation organic dyes that are long lasting (a fifty years test has been performed with excellent results). The inks were tested by Henry Wilhelm.

The paper is Arches, 100% rag and pH neutral. This particular paper was selected as it receives the inks best and added stability. Paper was used as the process required a smooth surface for image transfer and pigment manipulation. Once the image is created, it is adhered to a metal polylaminate with reversible archival pH neutral adhesive (A1023). When the glue cures, the surface is oprayed with three layers of Golden MSA UV filter coating, further increasing the permanency of the inks.
