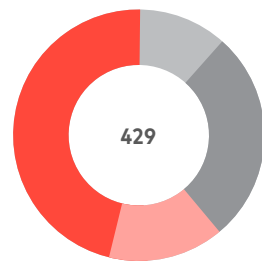

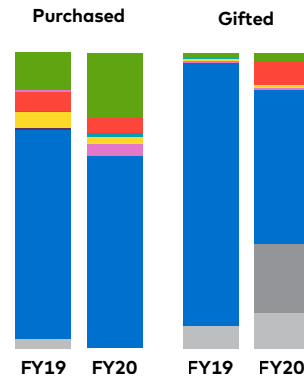

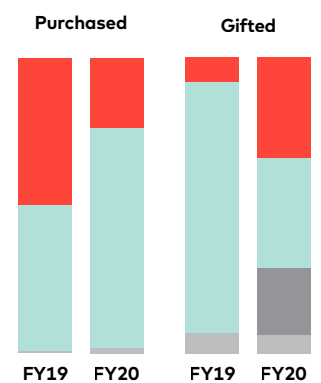

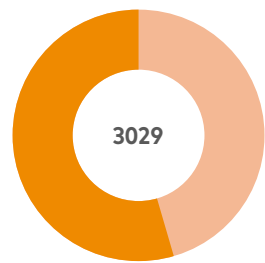

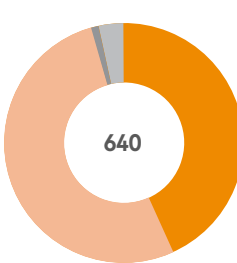
FY20 Total Objects on View
